On May 31st, 2025, the Odunpazarı Modern Museum (OMM) in Eskisehir hosted academic and designer Bora Sezer for an expert talk supported by İş Yatırım, focusing on the transformation of art, culture, and museum experiences through virtual reality. Widely recognized for his work in new-generation museology, Sezer highlighted the potential of VR to reshape visitor engagement, curatorial practices, and cultural interaction.
